** Only for Marshall residents. Call for current eligibility requirements.

*** State Emergency relief for bill payment has an annual maximum. Must have shut off notice or eviction notice to access services.

Help homeless w/1st month's rent up to \$500 but no security deposit; if being evicted, can apply for 1 month's rent.

Must demonstrate need, usually by presenting Medicaid card, Bridge card, WIC card or acquiring referral through 211. Can help individuals who have a barrier for employment (e.g., medical scrubs, steel-toed boots, etc.); referral comes from employer. Also hosts occasional clothing events.

#Must demonstrate emergency need as well as ID for every member of the family, including minors.

>For active duty/veterans and their households only (except dishonorably discharged and/or general court marshalled). Must verify homelessness and meet low income requirements or be at imminent risk of housing loss w/in 30 days.
