Shut off or past due notice required; \$300 limit/house/season/year if funds available/appropriate season.

Must demonstrate need, usually by presenting Medicaid card, Bridge card, WIC card or acquiring referral through 211. Can help individuals who have a barrier for employment (e.g., medical scrubs, steel-toed boots, etc.); referral comes from employer. Also hosts occasional clothing events.

Must demonstrate emergency need as well as ID for every member of the family, including minors to shop market; No ID or proof need required to eat at the Soup Kitchen.

>For veterans and their households only (except dishonorably discharged and/or general court marshalled). Must verify homelessness and meet low income requirements or be at imminent risk of housing loss w/in 30 days.
